The program begins at our Oxford, UK facilities, where students complete their ATPL Theory over a period of 36 weeks, followed by a 33 week flying program across our bases around the globe.

We offer EASA accredited pilot training at our purpose-built academies at London Oxford Airport, UK and Huesca Pirineos Airport, Spain and Gold Coast, Australia.

ATPL Theory

The 36-week program is divided into 3 modules, each followed by a set of EASA Exams under the supervision of the UK Civil Aviation Authority.

Module 1: General Navigation Air Law
Electrics, Systems & Engines.

Module 2: Principles of Flight Meteorology
Instruments Mass & Balance.

Module 3: Operational Procedures Radio
Communication Human
Performance & Limitations
Aircraft Performance Flight
Planning IFR Communications
VFR Communications.

STAGE 03

Initial & Advanced Flight Training

The 33 week program consists of 196.5 hours of flying and simulator time, using our Diamond DA40 & DA42 aircraft, and the FNPTII simulator, and is broken down as follows:

DA40 Single Engine

Solo - 54 hours
Dual - 47 hours
SPIC - 27 hours

DA42 Multi-Engine

Dual - 20.5 hours
SPIC - 2 hours
CPL & IR skill test - 4 hours

FNPTII Hours

42 hours

The flight training is continuous and has 5 progress tests which must be successfully passed to proceed to the next stage.

Multi-Pilot Foundation Jet Course (OPTIONAL)

- Multi-Crew Cooperation Course (MCC)
- Jet Orientation Course (UOC)
- A320/B737 sim instruction

This 2 week course is designed to take students from a single crew environment to a multi crew airline training environment in preparation for a career in commercial aviation. The course includes 25 hours of theory, and 20 hours of flying on an FNPTII-MCC Simulator.
